




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# Elderton BUZZ

## Vineyard and winery update

After a very long cold and wet winter the vineyard team were pleased to see the sun come out in September, which aided budburst in all varieties. Winter pruning was done well, and we have almost finished with the project to take the old vines down to single-wire trellising. We are very hopeful for a more abundant result than the last few years (which the rains will certainly help), where yields have been lucky to average over a tonne an acre for all three sites for three of the past four harvests.

In the winery, the countdown is on until the next bunch of vintage casuals come in to help us with what needs to be done at crush time. Richard and the team have been doing lots of barrel work in the cellar is ensuring that the 2012s, 13s and 14s are all looked after to ensure that they capture the attention of all Barossa wine lovers upon release.


