It often amazes us that the themes of globalisation have taken hold in our little agricultural pursuit as well. Only 30 or so years ago, wine in this country was the domain of small family operations who toiled for a modest return.

Today the production of wine is dominated by large multinationals. The retail arena has

also changed, becoming almost exclusively the realm of chain supermarkets that often seem hell bent on a race to the bottom and which openly state their intention to produce the majority of the wine they sell. Small winemakers are getting pushed out of these retailers every day, as we can attest, for wines that are generic and soullessly exist to promote the bottom line.

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### **Authenticity - Place - Tradition**

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When faced with a severe lack of options, we find the only thing to do is go into the cellar and find a wine from a family producer that we admire; a wine that has provenance; a bottle that is made by someone we love and trust and is from somewhere special, that represents authenticity and perhaps even traditions that many think have passed us by.

And then we enjoy it with friends and family in this beautiful part of the world, the Barossa Valley. We discover that life is still pretty good, regardless of any hassles we think we have.

We are thankful that we still have so

many like-minded supporters of our family business: good people who will go out of their way to find, cellar and drink wines produced by small and fervent producers who are at the top of their game.

Over 30 seasons of hard work by the Ashmead family, and by our wonderful team, have gone into making our wines that are grown from exceptional sites that we own, farm, and in which we believe. These wines don't move with fashion, or change to find show or press endorsement. These wines exist because of generational fortitude and because we know they deserve to be continued. Hopefully this is something worth celebrating.





## New exceptional vineyard - new wines

The Elderton Estate vineyard in Nuriootpa is the heart, soul and prestige of Elderton, but this may be about to change with the addition of one of the Barossa's greatest vineyards to the Ashmead's small collection of exceptional vineyard sites within the Barossa bounds.

In 2010 we purchased the 'Helbig Vineyard' in Greenock. This site was planted four generations ago and is today widely acclaimed by the winemaking elite of the Barossa. Many great winemakers have made wine from these vines, and many have wanted to, however the property is now solely in the hands of Elderton.


Greenock, located in the northwest corner of the Barossa Valley, is an elemental place, with undulating slopes and dried up creekbeds, hidden away in a hamlet that is only still there because of the stubborn, gnarled old vines that watch over it. Being on the Western Ridge of the Barossa, the altitude is higher than our Estate vineyard by some 60-80 metres. Therefore, the Greenock vineyard experiences cooler temperatures, has soils that are more mineral rich and an aspect that is very different from our other vineyards.

It is an exciting place, and we can now convey this through the 2012 wines:



### **Greenock One**

100% Greenock Shiraz made to be vibrant, structured, rich and powerful; the thing that sets it apart is the natural forceful tannins. We believe it easily stands up to other producer's wines at twice the price.
