
IT HAS STARTED..... CAM'S BLOG

WINE OF THE MONTH

2013 Ashmead Cabernet Sauvignon

(because in may not be around next month - very limited)

The hand harvested fruit for the 2013 Ashmead Cabernet Sauvignon was fermented in open top concrete fermenters with chilled ferments, hand pump-overs and cap submerging with oak header boards for eight days; the process finished with barrel and malolactic fermentation in new French oak.

The nose shows dark chocolate and black fruits and olives, with the palate continuing the theme. These typical Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon characters show weight and generosity in the wine with ripe tannins adding structure whilst being supple and mouth watering -
