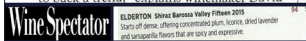


NEWS AND REVIEWS

BAROSSA

Australia's most famous wine region is known for old-vine Shiraz and Grenache bottling and GSM (Grenache-Shiraz-Mourvèdre) blends. Among the leaders making rich reds are Torbreck, Elderton and Powell & Son.

That said, the definition of Barossa is expanding as a new generation experiments with new styles. "I don't think we're trying to buck a trend," explains winemaker David

Shiraz Barossa Valley Fifteen 2015

Score: 94

Starts off dense, offering concentrated plum, licorice, dried lavender and sarsaparilla flavors that are spicy and expressive. Chocolate, cedar and sage notes come in the next wave, finishing in harmony, with a mouthful of velvety tannins. Drink now through 2030.

Cabernet Sauvignon Barossa Ashmead Single Vineyard 2015

Score: 92

Ripe, juicy blackberry and cherry flavors are generous and plump, with shadings of vanilla, toast and cedar. Notes of black licorice, espresso and Black Forest cake add an unctuous accent to the finish. The tannins are smooth and velvety. Drink now through 2027.

Shiraz Barossa Command Single Vineyard 2013

Score: 92

Notes of smoke and toast set the stage for the berry and plum flavors, showing a firm backbone and a supple texture. Elegant and spicy on the long finish. Drink now through 2028.

Shiraz Barossa 2015

Score: 88

Fresh, vibrant flavors of cherry, plum and strawberry are juicy and spicy, on a sleek frame, finishing with a distinct note of black tea. Drink now through 2028. 9,000 cases made.

Cabernet Sauvignon Barossa 2015

Score: 87

Cranberry, pomegranate and cherry flavors are tangy, with a firm edge of herbal details. Cedar and spice notes linger on the finish, where the tannins firm up. Drink now through 2028.

Flavors of fresh earth, dried leaves and peppery spices mingle with plum and cherry accents in this red, with tannins coming in on the finish, where a minty, resinous note lingers. Drink now through 2028. Tasted twice, with consistent notes.

2017 BAROSSA CABERNET SAUVIGNON

2016 was an incredible year for Cabernet Sauvignon, with great concentration. The warm dry Autumn was ideal for allowing the Cabernet grapes to reach optimal maturity, allowing the softening of tannins.
