VINTAGE UPDATE

Here at the vineyard and winery it is continuing to crank through the summer heat! No rain as yet, but at least some brief respite of temperatures of only 30+ for the vines, in amongst our 40+ heatwaves. We're keeping the vines and ourselves hydrated! Vintage 2019 is going to start quite a bit later than the last couple of years, and at this stage we are not expecting to start picking until March. To date in January we have had only 0.2mm of rain, which is dry! Yields will be down, but we are still expecting outstanding quality from across our three vineyards. The Riesling and Semillon in particular are riding through the heat very well, which is great to see.
